CLAWING BACK

Is a comprehensive document examining every aspect of the Clubs operations and brings forward over 40 recommendations for action

These recommendations support the following broad objectives

- redefine governance
- capitalise on our geographic advantage, and gain broader acceptance and support from within the 'Nightcliff Community'
- adopt a more holistic approach to coaching and junior development
- develop an A Grade playing group with a strong core of experienced local players within three years, and a regular stream of talent coming through from the junior program
- adopt a more aggressive and timely approach to recruiting with reduced reliance on 'fly in fly out' players

The working group will continue to liaise with Committee.

A workshop (or workshops) will be conducted shortly to review the current draft plan and finalise a detailed set of actions for implementation and ongoing monitoring.
